- Proficiency in English and preferably in Dutch

- Work independently, take initiative and meet deadlines

We offer a position as researcher at iMTA, preferably starting in October or November 2022. You will be offered a temporary contract of one year, with possibilities for extension. Remuneration will be in accordance with scale 10 of the Collective Labor Agreement for Dutch Universities (CAO NU) starting from \in 2,960 per month for a fulltime contract.
